WHAT INSPIRED YOU TO CREATE HAYLEY'S CHARACTER? HOW DID HER JOURNEY FROM VICTIM TO THRILLER WRITER DEVELOP IN YOUR MIND?

I am always thinking "what if" whenever I observe life around me. One day, I read an article about witness protection and wondered what it might be like to have to leave your family behind or to live in plain sight under a new alias. In Plain Sight was my original title but as Hayley's strength and resilience evolved it became Invincible.

WAS HAYLEY'S CAREER CHOICE AS A THRILLER WRITER UNDER A PSEUDONYM ALWAYS PART OF HER CHARACTER, OR DID THAT EVOLVE DURING THE WRITING PROCESS?

Hayley turned to her writing as a form of therapy, and I made her successful at it because of her invincible spirit. When she regained her strength and resolve, she was determined never to be dependent on anyone.

WHICH CHARACTER IN INVINCIBLE WAS THE MOST ENJOYABLE TO WRITE?

I enjoyed inserting Murdock in different scenes, showing his love of adventure, devotion to Hayley and Liam. Dogs are such loveable creatures. I also enjoyed Leo Murphy, the farmer's market vendor modeled after Ed Asner. He recognized Liam's love for Hayley and enjoyed teasing him about it.

WHAT DO YOU HOPE READERS TAKE AWAY FROM HAYLEY'S JOURNEY?

Believe in yourself and never give up on your dreams. Life happens but as long as we have a dream or goal to aspire for we need to keep moving ahead. Hayley was dealt some pretty heart wrenching blows and led a very lonely life for a while, but she didn't let that stop her from making something of her life. If you believe in yourself, you can do almost anything.



HOW LONG DID IT TAKE YOU TO WRITE THIS BOOK, FROM CONCEPTION TO PUBLICATION?

Probably four months. It just grabbed me, and I let it evolve.

WHICH SCENE WAS THE MOST EMOTIONAL ONE TO WRITE?

When Hayley saw her father for the first time in five years. My father passed away in 2012, and I think about him every day. It was also another way to show Liam's love for Hayley.

WHAT INSPIRED LIAM'S CHARACTER?

Tyler Hynes, the Hallmark actor, was my model for Liam. He's cute, has a special charisma with all the actresses he performs with, and has a natural sincerity no matter what part he plays. I wanted that for Liam. I wanted him strong enough to care about Hayley but also to give her the space and independence to make something of herself. His name – Liam – means strong-willed and protective.

HOW DID YOU DEVELOP HIS BACKSTORY?

I know someone that is in the Secret Service and feel for him as he is always on the road, away from his wife and children. As much as I appreciate his dedication to his work, I think about all he is missing with his family. I needed to connect Liam with Hayley's father somehow, so I gave him every man's worst nightmare – the tragic loss of family. It evolved after that as Liam came to find new love through Hayley.

WHAT MAKES LIAM THE PERFECT MATCH FOR HAYLEY?

He understood Hayley – her background and her spirit – and loved her enough to train her to be strong. True love is giving the ones you love the freedom to excel. Liam also understood the evil that was after Hayley. Again, his name – Liam – means strong-willed and protective

HOW DID YOU BALANCE HAYLEY'S NEED FOR INDEPENDENCE WITH HER GROWING FEELINGS FOR LIAM?

Hayley needed to learn to be strong and self-sufficient after witnessing her friend's murder. Much as she hated Liam's tough love training, she came to appreciate it as her confidence grew and made a new life for herself. When her new identity was compromised and her life was in danger, she discovered the extent that Liam had gone to, to protect her. She came to understand that accepting Liam's help wasn't a sign of weakness, but rather a different kind of strength. Through their shared ordeal, she discovered that true strength meant knowing when to stand alone and when to trust someone else to have your back which Liam had proven time and time again.

WHAT SCENE WAS THE MOST FUN TO WRITE?

I enjoyed the chapter where they went to Boston. The scene where Hayley met up with the ladies at the hotel and danced to *Shut Up and Dance with Me*. She was having fun and drew Liam into the act. I watched the dancers in the YouTube video over and over. That's when she fell in love with Liam.

WHAT CHARACTER OR SCENE WAS THE MOST CHALLENGING?

I'm not an evil person so Ortiz was a difficult character. Then I had to be careful with speckling information about him throughout the book.

WILL WE SEE ANY OF THE OTHER CHARACTERS IN ANY FUTURE BOOKS?

I might give Brandon his story. Maybe he and Liam will become partners with a security business. I could give him some Irish backstory with his ginger hair and personality.

I've also thought about writing a short story for Gerard Turner, Hayley's father, where he finds new love and offering it as a freebie to my community of readers.





CAN YOU SHARE A FASCINATING STORY OR EXPERIENCE YOU HAD WHILE RESEARCHING FOR THE BOOK?

I did a lot of researching for this book – self-defense, house plans, Vermont, Boston, Fenway Park – and I especially enjoyed researching jewelry once I decided how Liam was going to protect Hayley. I studied different necklace designs and that's how I came up with the diamond.

HOW HAS YOUR WRITING PROCESS EVOLVED?

My writing process has become my business, and I find that I am always plotting and learning ways to better my skill. It starts with a quick idea then a brief outline. Sometimes, I will draw circles on a page and plot, then connect the circles. I now have a box in my office that stores all of my notes on prospective scenes or plots. I check it from time to time when I'm looking for ideas.

I network with as many as ten fellow authors every week. I'm also a member of Outliers Writing University and enjoy networking with other famous authors who so generously share their knowledge.

WHAT'S THE MOST CHALLENGING PART?

Time. There never seems to be enough time in the day for all I want to do. I never thought that I would get up at 5:00 AM after retiring, but that is how I squeeze more hours out of the day for my creative writing.

WHAT ARE YOU WRITING NOW?

Another series - *The Bennett Auction Series* - about a family-owned auction business. It takes place in Edmondsville, the setting for *The Row series*. and has a ghost, serial killer and several smaller mysteries interwoven throughout.

Ingredients:

2 pounds ground beef
¾ pound ground lean pork
3 medium onions, chopped (about 1 ½ cups)
2 cloves garlic, minced
2 cans (1 pound each) diced tomatoes
2 cans (15 ounces each) tomato sauce
¼ cup parsley flakes plus another 2 Tablespoons
1 package lasagna noodles, cooked and drained
1 ½ pounds shredded mozzarella cheese



¼ cup sugar

- 2 teaspoons salt
- 2 teaspoons basil leaves
- 6 cups creamed cottage cheese
- 1 cup grated Parmesan cheese, plus another cup
- 2 teaspoons oregano leaves

1. Cook and stir ground beef, ground pork, onion and garlic in Dutch oven or kettle until meat is brown and onion is tender. Drain off fat.

2. Add tomatoes. Stir in tomato sauce, ¼ cup parsley flakes, the sugar, 2 teaspoons salt and basil. Heat to boiling, stirring occasionally. Reduce heat; simmer uncovered for about 1 hour or until mixture is consistency of spaghetti sauce.

3. Heat oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit. Mix cottage cheese, 1 cup Parmesan cheese, 2 Tablespoons parsley flakes, and oregano leaves. Reserve 1 cup meat sauce for thin top layer.

4. In each of 2 ungreased baking pans (13x9x2 inches), layer ¼ each of noodles, remaining meat sauce, mozzarella cheese and cottage cheese mixture; repeat. Spread reserved meat sauce over top; sprinkle each pan with ½ cup Parmesan cheese. (Lasagna can be refrigerated for several hours at this point until time to bake).

5. Bake uncovered for 45 minutes. (Allow an additional 10-15 minutes if lasagna has been refrigerated.) For easier cutting, let stand 15 minutes after removing from oven.
